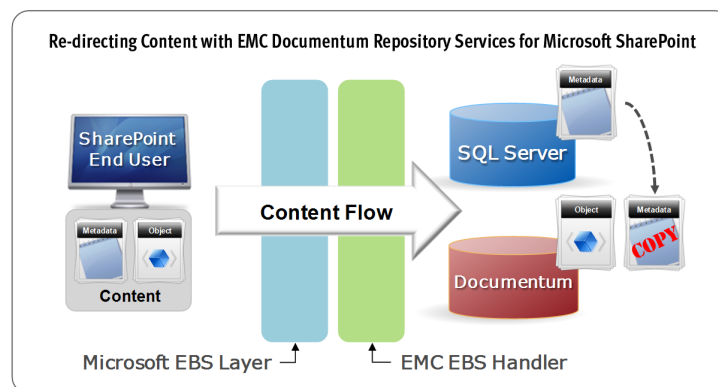
EMC[®] Documentum[®] Repository Services for Microsoft[®] SharePoint[®] enables organizations to manage SharePoint content as critical business information and leverage it for strategic advantage by re-routing content automatically to the EMC Documentum repository. Repository Services for Microsoft SharePoint aggregates content from disparate SharePoint sites, providing centralized management and the ability to apply compliance, business, and operational control to SharePoint content without impacting the end user.

Deliver a transparent experience to the SharePoint user

Most SharePoint to enterprise content management (ECM) storage solutions make use of shortcuts in SharePoint to 'point' at the content moved over to the ECM solution. These shortcuts are not transparent to SharePoint end users and can affect native Office integrations, full-text search, workflows, explicit document links, and other processes. A completely transparent solution, Repository Services for Microsoft SharePoint works differently. It intercepts unstructured content before it is written to Microsoft SQL Server[®] (SharePoint's native repository for content). SharePoint does not show that the content is being managed by Documentum and SharePoint users or tools are not affected.

Comply with regulatory, records management, and retention management requirements

Repository Services for Microsoft SharePoint aggregates and centrally manages content from SharePoint sites into centralized Documentum repositories. Organizations can leverage the capabilities of the EMC Documentum content management platform for secure content, including common policy enforcement across systems, utilization of existing retention and records processes, and structured disposition.



EMC Documentum Repository Services for Microsoft SharePoint directs the Binary Large Object (BLOB) as well as a copy of the metadata to the Documentum repository through the Microsoft External BLOB Storage (EBS) API and EMC EBS handler, leaving the original metadata file in SharePoint.



Manage explosive content growth and its associated costs

With Repository Services for Microsoft SharePoint, unstructured content is never stored in SharePoint with SQL Server repository. Instead, a single copy is stored in the Documentum repository, with no troublesome shortcuts left behind. This capability keeps the SQL Server repository from being overwhelmed by unstructured content, and provides organizations with the substantial cost savings associated with hierarchical storage management, de-duplication, and reduced SQL Server backup costs.

Extend the information infrastructure

Repository Services for Microsoft SharePoint stores content intelligently in the Documentum repository in a dynamically created folder location where policies and rules can be applied automatically. All of the SharePoint-related properties are stored in an accessible XML file for future use. Once stored in Documentum, the content can be managed in the same way as any other Documentum object—retention policies can be applied to the content and it can be categorized as a specific type of content, routed through a Documentum workflow, published to a website, and more.

Conclusion

EMC Documentum Repository Services for Microsoft SharePoint automatically redirects unstructured content normally destined for SharePoint with SQL Server to a Documentum enterprise content management repository. This capability improves overall content manageability, enhances performance and scalability across the organization's information infrastructure, and reduces storage costs.
