

2015 Sustainability Report Restatements

GHG and Energy

The following GHG and energy metrics were adjusted:

- GHG emissions from 2005 - 2014 were updated based on updates to emission factors, availability of additional invoiced data, and changes in our portfolio square footage. Additionally, Scope 2 emissions were updated based on changes in methodology and protocols.
- Global facilities electricity consumption (including VMware) was updated for 2010-2014 due to receipt of additional global energy data. 2014 consumption updated from 905,430 to 913,127 MWh and 3,259,548 to 3,287,257 GJ.
- Global facilities natural gas consumption (including VMware) was updated for 2010-2014 due to receipt of additional global energy data. 2014 consumption updated from 6,328,377 to 6,501,687 Therms [U.S.] and 667,520 to 685,964 GJ.

Global Water Withdrawal

2011 – 2014 water withdrawal values were adjusted based on changes in square footage and availability of additional water invoices. Invoice availability in 2014 was 70% rather than 75%, due to changes in portfolio square footage. 2014 water consumption was updated from 1,247,009 to 1,374,822 cubic meters.

Logistics

The percentage of our U.S. domestic freight that was transported by U.S. EPA SmartWay-member carriers in 2014 was revised and adjusted from 94% to 98%.

eWaste

2013 and 2014 audit findings on business elements and EHS were reviewed and adjusted to align with current (2015) audit protocol.

Community Involvement

2014 estimated EMC employee volunteer hours were adjusted from 586,243 to 138,840 hours due to errors in the original data set. We will be reviewing our methodology and targets going forward.
